Maryland is a host site piloting in 3 counties initially

- State CW Agencies that host NTI on their LMS and actively promoting (n=19)
- State CW Agencies actively using NTI on C.A.S.E. LMS/CapLEARN (n=11)
- State Child Welfare Agencies only promoting NTI in specific counties (n=1)
- State CW Agency uploaded training but not actively promoting NTI (n=2)

- ★ CW Agency with mandated positions to complete NTI (n=16)
- ▲ CW Agency provides incentives to complete NTI (n=11)
- CW Agencies in discussion to implement (n=5)
- Red Font Original NTI Pilot Sites (n=8)

States with Mandated Participation

CA- state adoption workers; staff in ASIST organizations (working with youth transitioning from residential care)

DC – Direct service social workers & family support workers; mental health clinicians

GA – Adoption staff/supervisors

IA – adoption staff & supervisors; contracted post-adopt providers

IL – Contracted Adoption preservation providers

IN – Adoption staff

LA – Adoption and Home Development specialists & supervisors

ME – Adoption staff & supervisors

MT – Resource Family Specialists

ND – AASK adoption specialists and post-adoption coordinators & supervisors

SC – Child welfare staff & team leaders

SD – Family services specialists, children’s workers, adoption specialists & supervisors

TX – Adoption staff and foster adoptive home development workers & supervisors

VT – Adoption and post-adoption staff

States Providing Incentives

DC – Protected time for clinicians

IN – Protected time

LA – Protected time; CE’s provided

MS – Protected time; CE’s; Supervisory team discussions after completion of assigned modules

ND – Supervisor follow-up following modules to support application to practice

NE – Training counts toward 24 annual training requirement

NJ – Training credits

SC – Training is embedded in professional development plans

SD – Protected time

VT – CE’s offered to LMSW completers
