We served more families than ever and extended our national programmatic focus on education through our National Training Institute's School-Based Mental Health Professionals Training (NTI-Ed) and The C.A.S.E. Academy for mental health professionals, while growing our national footprint as a leader in the mental health and adoption, foster and kinship care space.

Fund-a-Family Scholarship Program

In 2024, your generosity helped provide resources that improved the mental health of **309 clients and their families**, who were not able to afford the cost of therapy and were not eligible for grant-funded services.

Thanks to you, C.A.S.E. was able to offer more than **\$228,000 in financial assistance** to residents of D.C., Maryland, and Virginia.

Your support created the pathway for **94 families** to participate in our services, engaging in more than **1,000 treatment sessions** to heal and develop better coping skills to manage anxiety, depression, ADHD, and other diagnoses. With your help, the families we serve are thriving.

Advancing Learning to Build a National Network of Professionals

In 2023, your generosity helped us launch our National Training Initiative School-Based Mental Health Professionals curriculum (NTI-Ed) to help them address the complex educational and behavioral needs of children in adoptive, foster, and kinship families.

Thanks to your continued support in 2024, nearly **300 donors** raised over **\$300,000** to provide free training so school professionals could better understand the underlying behaviors of children who have experienced trauma, grief, and loss.

With your continued support, we can further the access and participation of school based mental health professionals in this training, helping even more children.

2024 National Training Institute Numbers

8,645 individuals registered for **10** Strengthening Your Family Webinars and **4** additional webinars offered to the public.

978 individuals were provided training through **30** contracted trainings, workshops and community presentations offered by C.A.S.E.

10 new licensed WISE Up! Sites completed the WISE Up! Train the Trainer program.

283 individuals participated in **7 support group series** for parents or adult adoptees.

2,322 child welfare and mental health professionals enrolled in the National Adoption Competency Mental Health Training Initiative (NTI) trainings for a total of **24,772 enrolled** since 2017.

1,277 school-based mental health professionals have enrolled in the School-Based Mental Health Professionals Training (adapted from NTI) which launched in September 2023.

442 on-demand webinars were accessed by parents and professionals.

NTI and NTI-Ed staff either exhibited and/or presented at **15 conferences** in 2024.

At the completion of 2024, **1,200+ school-based mental health professionals** representing school districts in **47 states** had enrolled in the training nationwide. In a recent survey of first year NTI-Ed participants...

91% who responded and completed training were satisfied with the training

98% agreed the training is relevant to their job

93% agreed that the training will or has already enhanced their effectiveness related to working with youth and families.

Broadening C.A.S.E.’s Regional and National Brand Recognition and Reach

In 2024 C.A.S.E. engaged nearly **700 individuals** and raised over **\$450,000** through our signature special events – Our Annual Golf Tournament, Our Denim & Diamonds Gala and Kids Adoption Network Conference. These events provided opportunities to introduce emerging supporters to C.A.S.E and bring together so many of you who have been embracing our mission over the years. Your generosity provided immediate resources to support our current programming and growth. Partnerships from these events led to both television and radio broadcast features and in-person events where we could further promote our work and increase our brand recognition.
